Location/Parking

The Milwaukee Mile raceway is located in the WI State Fair Park, at 640 South 84th Street, West Allis, WI 53214. It is located 12 miles east of our host hotel.

Entrants with and without trailers and spectators must enter the track through Gate 5, located on South 84th Street. Trailer parking will open at 12 noon on Thursday, June 26 and 8am on Friday, June 27.



Harry A. Miller Club History

Harry A. Miller was born in Menomonie, WI in 1875. His curiosity and genius led him to build his first carburetors and pistons in 1907. Miller gained prominence after moving to Los Angeles, CA where he went on to build his infamous Miller designed engines and cars. His well-known 122 front-wheel-drive racing car was introduced to the public in 1924. Harry Miller is regarded as America's greatest race car and engine designer.

The late David V. Uihlein, Sr. founded the Harry A. Miller Club in 1995 to make sure this Wisconsin native's legacy continued. The Club's annual Millers at Milwaukee – Vintage Indy Car Event offers members the opportunity to run and display their vintage race cars, and to share with the public the accomplishments of Harry A. Miller. Tedd Zamjahn is the current Harry Miller Club president.

Eligible Cars

All front engine pre and post-WWII Indy cars and open-wheel Champ cars, Indy Roadsters, and laydown cars are eligible to apply for entry. We are also including pre-WWII open wheel Grand Prix Cars.

In addition, rear engine authentic Offenhauser and/or Meyer/Drake Indianapolis cars are eligible to apply. The car must be originally built as a race car, powered by one of these engines, and must not be modified from a car born with a different power plant.

A photo and car description are required for review prior to entry approval. Only 60 cars will be accepted.
